Why focus on anti-Black racism?

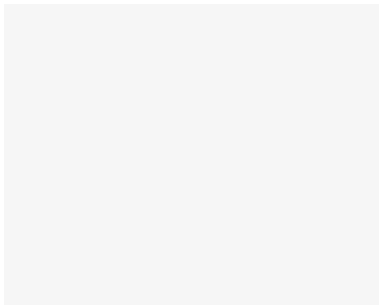
Why is it necessary to invest in Black-led social change?

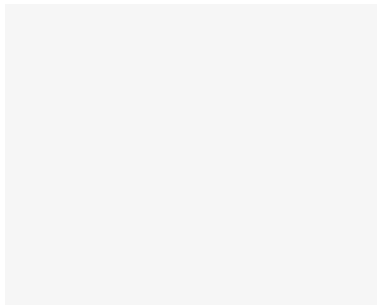
