Annual Harambee Conference & Convening

This year's conference will be in the great city of Atlanta, which is considered as the spiritual center for the Civil Rights movement. Atlanta was also a key city for the Confederacy in the mid 1800's during the (un) Civil War. Some even call Atlanta the "Black Mecca;" yet we continue to bear witness to -- and fight against--some of the same anti-Black racism once depicted in "Gone with the Wind" – same script; different cast.

In support of Atlanta and the communities we serve, please join us at Harambee, the premier gathering for Black professionals in organized philanthropy from April 6-9, 2025 (pre-conference activities launching April 6th). We will unite local, national, and global leaders in tribute to the Civil Rights "movers and shakers," and in celebration of culture, community, and change.

Harambee will host several networked groups across ABFE's memberships for key convenings during our time in Atlanta. They include:

- The Umoja Circle A Black Foundation CEO Network started virtually in 2020, with the convening of Black foundation Presidents and CEOs, and gave rise to ABFE's Call to Action, "We Must be in it for The Long Haul". We hope to have a record number of Black leaders join us at the conference for this gathering.
- Leverage the Trust Track We invite Black foundation trustees to continue building a learning network.
- **Connecting Leaders Fellowship Program** We invite the almost 200 CLFP Alum to join us and celebrate one another and meet our 2024-25 cohort at a very special annual reception.
- James A. Joseph Lectures Awardees There is always room in the village to welcome our growing network of recipients of the James A. Joseph Lecturers: Emerging Leaders, Trailblazer, and Institutional award winners.
- The Corporate Community of Practice We welcome corporate philanthropy and giving professionals who are committed to supporting more racially equitable practices in support of Black communities.
- Network Meetups (funder collaboratives and regional Blacks in Philanthropy (BIP) We reserve space for local networks to meet.
